Foil faced Polyethylene Insulation

Disposable Decontamination Units



As many of you will be aware we have been distributing the Avail range of Glovebags manufactured by Grayling of Atlanta, Georgia, USA since the late 1980's. We have now added to this range the Grayling three stage disposable asbestos decontamination units. These units manufactured from heavy duty polyethylene consist of three compartments (wet-dry-wet), are quick to erect, delivered in a carton approx 1200mm x 1200mm x 300mm and are suitable for multiple use subject to cleaning between uses. Application Note

B.C.A. Insulation thicknesses for hot/cold pipes

It does seem that a large number of our customers are not aware of the insulation thicknesses required to meet the requirements of the Building Code of Australia. Accordingly, a number of customers are purchasing product that is "over thickness" for their requirements.

From our web site, you can download tables detailing the thickness of insulation required for all pipe sizes from 12.7mm odp to 219mm odp for all R-values from R0.6 to R2.7. Tables are available for rockwool, fibreglass & Foil Faced PE spi.

For pipe sizes larger than 219mm odp please contact our office and we will provide detailed thicknesses for you.
